POSICON 2023

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

Scientific Research can be presented at POSICON 2023, Bhubaneswar in the following two categories:

- 1. Podium presentations
- 2. Poster
 - o Free paper 5 minutes+ 2 minutes discussion
 - o Best paper 7 minutes + 2 minutes discussion

Important Dates:

Last Date for Submission of Abstracts: August 31, 2022

Registered delegates can present a maximum of 1 Podium presentation and any number of e-Posters.

We encourage original research work. All abstracts will be reviewed by panel of experts and then would be accepted as for podium / poster presentations during the POSICON 2023, Bhubaneswar.

Guidelines for abstract submission:

- Only registered delegates will be allowed to submit the abstract for paper/poster
- The presenting author shall be the contact person for all future correspondence. Only the
 presenting author will receive the presentation certificate. Once submitted, the names or
 sequence of the authors cannot be changed / added
- All abstracts must be submitted online via the conference website ONLY
- Please indicate whether it is being submitted as a paper or poster
- Case reports are generally not accepted unless they bring significant and novel scientific information. They may be converted to poster presentations, at the discretion of the scientific committee
- One registered delegate can have only one presentation in the free paper category
- Last date for submission of Abstracts is 31ST August, 2022
- All submissions will be acknowledged by email, mentioned in your registration details
- By submission of an abstract, the author transfers copyright ownership to the organizing committee for publications. The Organizing committee reserves the right to reproduce the abstract/presentation made in conference in print or electronic media
- Abstracts / papers previously published or presented at any national or international meeting are not permitted.
- The Scientific committee will review the abstracts & the acceptance will be communicated to the presenting author by 1st November, 2022
- Based on the score received from the reviewers, the scientific committee will allocate best paper / free paper / poster.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to allocate a session time or change the presentation type.

Instructions for Abstract Content:

- All abstracts are to be submitted in English
- The title should be short and concise, & must NOT be written in capital letters
- Structured abstract with introduction, aim & objectives, materials & methods, results, conclusion to be submitted.
- The abstract should be within 300 words.
- No references are needed with abstract submission.
- Use generic names of drugs only.
- Standard abbreviations should be used. While using unusual abbreviations, it should be in brackets after the full word, when it appears for the first time
- Use numerals to indicate numbers, except when beginning the sentences.

Scientific Research papers will be presented at POSICON 2023 in the following categories:

- 1. POSI Best Paper Award (Competitive) (Podium) 7+2 minutes
- 2. POSI Free Paper (Podium) 5+2 minutes
- 3. e-Posters (Competitive)
- 4. POSI Dr Kameshita Young Surgeon's Forum

Important Dates

Last Date for Submission of Abstracts: August 31, 2022

Registered delegates can present a maximum of 1 podium presentation

The POSI scientific committee will decide whether your podium presentation will be in the best paper / free paper / e-Poster category.

Stepwise submission process:

Step1: Enter your conference registration number. You will not be allowed to submit an abstract without having registered for the conference

- Step 2: Select the category for abstract submission
 - Podium
 - e-Poster

Each registered delegate can submit any number of abstracts.

- Step 3: Enter the Title of the presentation
- Step 4: Select sub-speciality for your presentation. Choose at least one category that is mandatory.
- **Step 5**: Enter the name of the authors. Only the presenting author will receive the conference certificate. Once submitted, author names cannot be changed/added.
- **Step 6:** Enter the abstract in MS Word format with Arial Font, size 12. Abstract should be written under the following heads: **Introduction, Aims & Objectives, Material & Methods, Results and Conclusions** without names of the authors or the institution.
- Step 7: Select the number of co-authors and give their names.
- Step 8: After competition click on Submit Abstract, and your Abstract will be submitted.
- Step 9: Once you click the Submit Abstract button the submission will be completed and no further changes will be possible.
- Step 10: If you want to submit another abstract click on the button Submit new abstract
- Step 11: You will receive a confirmation message by email that your submission has been successful.
